# ★ Getting From Dublin Airport to Dublin City Centre — The Friendly, Fuss-Free Guide

Welcome to Ireland! Just touched down and wondering how to get into the heart of Dublin? Whether you're here to explore castles, coastlines, or cosy pubs, this handy guide will get you from the airport to your hotel — and ready for your big Irish adventure.

#### The Essentials

- Dublin Airport is just 10km north of the city centre.
- Travel time: Around **20–30 minutes**, depending on traffic.
- The airport has **two terminals**: T1 and T2. Most North American flights arrive into T2.
- There's **no train service**, but taxis and coaches are easy to find.
- T1 and T2 are a 5-minute walk apart.

**Tip:** Aer Lingus, Delta, United and American Airlines usually land at T2. Ryanair, Air Canada and others use T1. Check with your airline just to be sure!

# 🚖 Our Top Pick: Grab a Taxi

If you're jetlagged, have a suitcase that weighs as much as a small elephant, or you're travelling with a group — taxis are a brilliant option.

#### Why We Recommend It:

- Door-to-door drop-off at your hotel or B&B
- Use of **bus lanes**, making the ride faster
- 24/7 availability
- Cost: €20–36, depending on traffic, time, and hotel location

In a rush? Ask your driver to take the **Dublin Port Tunnel**. It's a little extra in tolls but can knock 10+ minutes off your trip.

# Aircoach – All Day, All Night

- Route 700 runs to the city 24/7
- Picks up at both terminals
- Every 15 mins (daytime), every 30 mins (late night)
- €7 one way / €12 return
- Get off at Gresham Hotel stop (O'Connell Street) for the Point A Hotel or Irish Experience Tours pick-up point

Ideal for: Budget-savvy solo travellers and night owls.

# Airlink Express (Route 747)

- Fast, comfy and uses the **Port Tunnel**
- €6 one way / €11 return
- Accepts the Leap Card
- Runs every 10 minutes, 7 days a week
- Get off at O'Connell Street a short walk to your hotel and pick-up point

## Dublin Express Coach

• Routes 782 & 784 to central Dublin

- €8 one way / €10 return (cheaper online!)
- Free Wi-Fi + USB ports on board
- Runs frequently from early morning to late evening
- Serves O'Connell Street, Christchurch, Heuston Station, and more

**Great option** if you're staying near Point A Hotel or along the route from O'Connell to Heuston Station.

# **Bonus: Leap Visitor Card**

Want to hop on and off Dublin's buses, trams, and trains? Grab a Leap Visitor Card:

- €10 (1 day), €19.50 (3 days), €40 (7 days)
- Includes Airlink, Dublin Bus, Luas, and DART
- Available at Spar shops or info desks in both terminals
